Requirements of article/reports:

- compliance with the conference theme;
- size until 4 pages of A4 format;
- text format text editor Word;
- printing type "Times New Roman", "KZ Times New Roman" 14 pt;

- margins: 2 cm from all sides;
- line spacing -1;

- alignment in width;
- paragraph 1.25cm;
- references to literature are indicated in square brackets (before a point);
- figures are located in the text after the first link, the name and numbers of figures (Figure 1 Name of the figure) are indicated under the figures, alignment in the center;
- tables are located in the text after the first link, the names and numbers of tables (Table 1 Table name) are indicated above the tables, alignment to the left, without a paragraph;
 - printing type in tables and figures not less than 12 pt.
 - the list of references is attached at the end of the article.

In the upper-left corner, specify the UDC-without a paragraph; through the line in the center – the title of the article/report (in capital bold letters); through the line in the center – the surname and initials of the author (s); on the next line in the center – the name of the educational institution or organization, city, country;

Through the line, in italics, a short abstract/summary, for articles/reports in Russian "түйін" and "summary", for articles/reports in Kazakh "резюме" and "summary", for articles/reports in English «түйін» and «резюме» (in italics);

Separated by a line – the main text typed with a single line spacing; the list of references to which there are references in the text in the form [1] is indicated at the end of the main text with an indent of one line.

The sources in the list of references are arranged in the order in which they are mentioned in the text and are drawn up according to the following rules: the surname and initials of the author(s), the name of the source, the place of publication, the publisher, the year (for conference proceedings – city, country, year), the numbering is continuous.

We draw your attention to the need to submit materials in a carefully edited form in compliance with all the above requirements.

The organizing committee is not responsible for materials that do not contain scientific novelty or are designed with a violation of grammar.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject materials.

The deadline of sending materials for publication: November 6, 2022.
