- an article for publication, designed in accordance with the requirements (in the file name it is necessary to specify the last name of the author(s) of the article, for example: Tolgatov B.) (*Appendix 2*);
- a receipt for payment of the organizational fee (*must be attached as a separate file*).

Articles are allowed to be published if they confirm the originality of at least 70% in the system. Strikeplagiarism.com . A joint team of authors – up to 3 people.

After receiving the materials, the author will be notified by e-mail about the receipt and the results of their review.

The registration fee for the publication of an article / report in an electronic collection is:

- for teachers and undergraduates of Miras University free of charge;
- for external participants 4000 tenge.

Payment is accepted through the **kaspi.kz** application:

Requirements of article/reports:

- compliance with the conference theme;
- size until 4 pages of A4 format;
- text format text editor Word;
- printing type "Times New Roman", "KZ Times New Roman" 14 pt;
- margins: 2 cm from all sides;
- line spacing –1;
- alignment in width;
- paragraph 1.25cm;
- references to literature are indicated in square brackets (before a point);

• figures are located in the text after the first link, the name and numbers of figures (Figure 1 - Name of the figure) are indicated under the figures, alignment in the center;

- tables are located in the text after the first link, the names and numbers of tables (Table 1
- Table name) are indicated above the tables, alignment to the left, without a paragraph;
- printing type in tables and figures not less than 12 pt.
- the list of references is attached at the end of the article.
- In the upper-left corner, specify the UDC-without a paragraph;
- through the line in the center the title of the article/report IN CAPITAL LETTERS in bold;
- through the line in the center the surname and initials of the author (s) (in a regular font);

• on the next line in the center – the name of the educational institution or organization, city, country (in a regular font);

• Through the line, *in italics*, a short abstract/summary:

-for articles/reports in Russian «Түйін» и «Summary»;

-for articles/reports in Kazakh «Резюме» и «Summary»,

-for articles/reports in English «Түйін» и «Резюме».

• Separated by a line – the main text, typed with a single line spacing, width alignment. If necessary, **bold**, *italics*, and <u>underscores</u> are used to highlight a part of the text.

• Separated by a line – the main text typed with a single line spacing; the list of references to which there are references in the text in the form [1] is indicated at the end of the main text with an indent of one line.

• The sources in the list of references are arranged in the order in which they are mentioned in the text and are drawn up according to the following rules: the surname and initials of the author(s), the name of the source, the place of publication, the publisher, the year (for conference proceedings – city, country, year), the numbering is continuous.
